### Points

In the event of the points being tied at the end of a Series the following order will be decided by the following:

4. Toss of a coin...



### Presentation Night & Awards

### By Rules for Premier League Tournament

4. Max of 2 Players may be dropped down a grade per Tournament any amount of players may come up
