Thank you for the interest shown in our competitions, and for taking the time to read this information sheet on Action Indoor Cricket and the seasonal competitions that we currently have available.

All of our competitions are fully serviced, with all necessary playing equipment, match umpires and competition administration being provided by each Stadium.

Prior to the start of each season we will place your team into the grade that we feel best suits your team's ability, and we then constantly monitor all grades during each season to make sure that we are providing all teams with the most evenly matched competition available.

The match rules applied to our seasonal leagues are the official rules of New Zealand Indoor Cricket as published by New Zealand Indoor Sports Incorporated, and are in accordance with the official rules established by the World Indoor Cricket Federation.

To help make the organisation of your team as easy as possible, at the start of each season you will be given a competition draw, and this draw will include the dates and times for your complete season's games prior to semi-finals.

To further assist you in this task, your team's competition draw, full match results and position on the competition ladder are also available 24 hours a day by visiting us at www.actionindoorsports.com

GAME BASICS

- An Indoor Cricket team is comprised of six players.
- Each game consists of two innings, with each innings being made up of twelve six ball overs.
- Each player must bowl two overs and bat in a partnership for four overs.
- Batters may be dismissed in any of the manners associated with the traditional outdoor game, and they may also be caught out from the nets surrounding the court.
- When either batter is dismissed, runs are deducted from the batting teams score and both batters continue to bat until their four overs have been faced.
- A batter cannot be given out LBW if they have attempted to play a shot.
- If the batters fail to score any runs from two successive deliveries (wides and no balls are classified as scoring), they must score from the following delivery or the fielding team will be awarded a dismissal.
- Runs are scored through a combination of physical and zonal runs.
- Physical runs are scored when the batters cross and successfully make their ground, and Zonal runs are scored when the ball is played into the nets surrounding the court. Zonal runs will only be awarded if a physical run has been completed off the same delivery.
- All Wides and No Balls bowled will result in two runs being added to the batting teams score, and any such balls bowled in the last over of an innings may be re-bowled should the batter at the crease agree.
- A full set of match rules are available from the stadium.
- All teams are graded at the beginning of each season and then re-graded where necessary during the season to ensure the best standard of competition possible.
- All necessary playing equipment, match umpires and a comprehensive competition management system are provided by the stadium.

COMPETITION INFO

COMPETITION FORMAT

A typical season consists of pre-season grading games, competition round games, and depending on how your team has fared in the round games, semi-finals and finals. All finals are held on the same day, and prizes are awarded to the winners and runners up in all grades.

PLAYING DAYS

Each team will have their games scheduled on both their preferred playing day and if necessary on a Sunday. Games will only be scheduled on a Sunday if the number of teams entering each competition makes this necessary.

At this stage we do not envisage any teams having to play games on a Sunday during the coming season, but should this become necessary all teams will be expected to play these games as they will all form a part of the overall competition.

Following are the days on which our Indoor Cricket competitions are played...

Adult Indoor Cricket - Mon/Tue/Wed/Thu and Sun

PLAYING TIMES

To enable us to provide your teams with the most suitable schedule of game times possible, when entering your team you must select which time zones are best suited to your team on both your preferred playing day and on Sundays.

MATCH FEES

All of our competitions are run on a pay as you play basis, with each team simply having to pay their team's match fee prior to the start of each scheduled game.

Our current fees are as follows...

Senior Indoor Cricket - \$54.00 per team per match

To enable us to maintain our payment structure, all teams must play all of their scheduled games. If a team defaults any game without providing the Stadium with at least 72 hours prior notice, such team will be charged a default fee equivalent to one team's full match fee.

SEASON TIMINGS

Our competitions run all year round, and following is a schedule of the timings in which each of our competitions are played.

Adult Summer League	November to March
Adult Autumn League	March to July
Adult Winter League	July to November
Junior Summer League	October to March
Junior Winter League	May to September

Please note that there are only limited spaces available per season and teams will be accepted into the competition in the order in which they are received.

- Select which time zones best suit your team on both your preferred playing day and on Sundays.
