GAME BASICS

- Seven players may take part in any one game, with a maximum of four players being permitted on the court at any one time.
- Each game consist of two eighteen minute halves.
- An indoor soccer court is divided into halves, and marked with a goal semi-circle at either end of the court.
- Each team is comprised of a set Goal Keeper and three Outfield players. Outfield players may move anywhere within the court with the exception of either goal semi-circle.
- Goal Keepers must remain in their designated goal semi-circle at all times.
- Mixed teams must have a minimum of one female player and a maximum of two male players on the court at all times, and one male player must be in the position of Goal Keeper.
- In the mixed grades, successful shots at goal taken by a male player are worth one point, and successful shots at goal by a female player are worth two points.
- The nets surrounding the court may all be used to make or receive passes to or from another player.
- A player interchange system is used that allows teams to freely replace players at any stage of the game.
- Players are not permitted to tackle from behind or by means of sliding.
- Players are not permitted to hold onto the nets at any time whilst either in possession of the ball or attempting to tackle an opposition player in possession of the ball.
- Over aggressive or dangerous play will not be tolerated under any circumstances, and Stadium Management reserves the right to remove any player or team not playing within the Spirit of the Game.
- All teams are graded at the beginning of each season and then re-graded where necessary during the season to ensure the best standard of competition possible.
- All of our competitions are run on a pay as you play basis, with each team simply having to pay their team's match fee prior to the start of each scheduled game.

COMPETITION INFO

COMPETITION FORMAT

A typical season consists of pre-season grading games, competition round games, and depending on how your team has fared in the round games, semi-finals and finals. All finals are held on the same day, and prizes are awarded to the winners and runners up in all grades.

PLAYING DAYS

Each team will have their games scheduled on both their preferred playing day and if necessary on a Sunday. Games will only be scheduled on a Sunday if the number of teams entering each competition makes this necessary.

At this stage we do not envisage any teams registered during the week having to play games on a Sunday during the coming season, but should this become necessary all teams will be expected to play these games as they will all form a part of the overall competition.

Following are the days on which our competitions are played...

- Mens Indoor Soccer - Tuesday and Sunday
- Mixed Indoor Soccer - Tuesday and Sunday
- Junior Indoor Soccer - Friday

PLAYING TIMES

To enable us to provide your teams with the most suitable schedule of game times possible, when entering your team you must select which time zones are best suited to your team on both your preferred playing day and on Sundays.

MATCH FEES

All of our competitions are run on a pay as you play basis, with each team simply having to pay their team's match fee prior to the start of each scheduled game. Our current fees are as follows...

- Senior Indoor Soccer - \$36.00 per team per match
- Junior Indoor Soccer - \$24.00/\$30.00 per team per match

To enable us to maintain our payment structure, all teams must play all of their scheduled games. If a team defaults any game without providing the Stadium with at least 72 hours prior notice, such team will be charged a default fee equivalent to one team's full match fee.

SEASON TIMINGS

Our competitions run all year round, and following is a schedule of the timings in which each of our competitions are played.

Adult Summer League	November to March
Adult Autumn League	March to July
Adult Winter League	July to November
Junior Summer League	October to April

Please note that there are only limited spaces available per season and teams will be accepted into the competition in the order in which they are received.

HOW TO ENTER

To enter into one of our weekly leagues, simply...

- Select your preferred playing day during the week.
- Select which time zones best suit your team on both your preferred playing day and on Sundays.
- Fill out the entry form opposite and get it back to us a.s.a.p
