COMPETITION FORMAT

- Our competition is for school children, boys & girls, 8 years of age and older.
- All teams consist of eight players
- Teams play against teams of a similar age and/or ability.
- Each team will be outfitted in playing shirts for each match.
- All games are played on either Fridays or Sundays.
- The competition commences on the first Friday of the second school term and concludes on the last Friday of the third school term.
- No games will be scheduled to be played during School Holidays.
- Games last for approximately seventy minutes.
- The first round of games will start at 3.40pm on Fridays and 10.00am on Sundays.
- All games are played in accordance with the official rules of **Action Indoor Cricket**, a copy of which will be given to all teams prior to the start of the competition.
- A game of indoor cricket sees all players bowling two overs, batting in a partnership lasting four overs and spending sixteen overs fielding.
- Batters are dismissed by being either bowled, stumped, run out, hit wicket, caught (either direct or off any nets), LBW, interference, or for Indoor Cricket's own version of the "Strike Three" rule.
- Batters continue batting regardless of how many times they are dismissed. Five (5) runs are deducted for each dismissal.
- Runs are scored when both batters successfully complete a physical run between the creases.
- If the ball is played into the net from the bat, zone runs are also scored, but only if a physical run has also been made.
- All teams entering each competition must pay a \$40.00 Team Registration at the time of entering their team.
- Each team must also pay a match fee prior to the start of each game. Our current match fees are \$40.00 per team per match for grades up to and including the 15 and under grade, and \$56.00 per team per match for those teams in or above the 16 years and under grade.
- All necessary playing equipment, match umpires and competition administration will be provided by the Stadium and are included in the above fees to be paid by all teams.

JUNIOR NATIONALS

Action Indoor Sports administer New Zealand's only annual National Indoor Cricket Tournament for school aged children, with teams from Action Indoor Sports Stadiums throughout New Zealand travelling to compete in this event.

Not only is the level of cricket at this event a real challenge for all players, the entire tournament experience proves to be a whole lot of fun for all involved.

All players taking part in our World Series Indoor Cricket competition are welcome to attend selection trials for this event, and full details of the tournament will be made available to all players and teams as the season progresses.



HOW TO ENTER

- Either get your friends together and organise a full team of eight players, or enter as an individual and be placed in a team.
