THE ACTION TEAM

NETBALL BASICS

- Each game consists of four eight minute quarters.
- Eight players may take part in any one game, with a maximum of six players being permitted on the court at any one time.
- There are three playing positions, Attack, Centre and Defence.
- Attack players are permitted to move anywhere within their team's attacking half, including the goal circle.
- Defence players are permitted to move anywhere within their team's defending half, including the goal circle.
- Centre players are permitted to move anywhere within the entire court, with the exception of the goal circles at either end of the court.
- Mixed teams must have a minimum of one and a maximum of three male players on the court at all times, and two male players may not occupy the same position.
- Successful shots at goal taken from within the goal circle by an Attack player are worth one point.
- Successful shots at goal taken from outside of the goal circle by either an Attack or Centre Player are worth two points.
- The nets surrounding the court may all be used to either make or receive passes to or from another player.
- The remaining match rules are based on the traditional outdoor game, and are contained in a rule book that is available to all teams.

STADIUM POLICY

COMPETITION FORMAT

A typical season consists of two pre-season grading games, 14 competition round games, and depending on how your team has fared in the round games, semi-finals and finals. All finals are held on the same day, and prizes are awarded to the winners and runners up in all grades.

SEASON TIMINGS

The season commences on Friday 16th October 2009 and concludes for this school year on Sunday 20th December 2009.

The season re-commences in 2010 on Friday 5th February and concludes with Grand Finals day on Friday 26th March.

PLAYING DAYS

The majority of each team's games will be scheduled on a Friday, but there will be some games scheduled to be played on Sundays during each competition and all teams are expected to play all scheduled games.

PLAYING TIMES

Games will commence from 4pm on Fridays and from midday on Sundays with lower grades playing the earlier times and the higher grades the later times.

REGISTRATION FEES

Each team must pay a \$40.00 Team Registration Fee, and this fee must be paid prior to each team's first game.

MATCH FEES

We now offer two methods of payment, pay as you play or pay the whole season up front..

Junior Netball: Pay as you play...-\$36.00 per team per match

Junior Netball: Pay up front.... -\$30.00 per team per match

CANCELLATION OF GAMES

To enable us to maintain our payment structure, all teams must play all of their scheduled games. If a team cancels or defaults any game the following will apply:

Cancellation of any game will incur a \$30.00 default fee regardless of any notice given.

SEASON TIMINGS

Our competitions commence from the first Friday of the fourth term, will break for the Christmas school holidays, and recommence the first Friday of term one the following year.
