Registration Conditions: All teams competing at Action Indoor Sports Stadium agree to abide by conditions of entry (see back of registration form) rules of game, stadium policy and local bi-rules as set out by Stadium Management.

TEAM CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

Please ensure your team reads, understands and agrees to the following:

1. Rules of the Game
2. Local Stadium Policy
3. Local bi-rules of game (if any).

- **PAYMENTS** – individual player registration \$6 is required by every team member up to 12 players. Team payment is required each game regardless of players. Teams must pay in full at start of game and complete game card. Please no individual payments unless authorised by Management. Discounts are given for full team payment at start of season 5% discount applies.
- **Registered Teams** - Teams registered in leagues have made a playing commitment for the league duration. Teams wanting to permanently leave a league must give a minimum of 3 weeks notice to Management. Teams who are not able to give 3 weeks notice must pay 3 weeks game fees if they do not wish to play the notice period.
- **DEFAULTS** - *Please avoid!! All defaults incur full team payment.*
Teams who give notice are still liable for full team payment. Teams defaulting on day or not showing up at all will incur -10 penalty points and may be liable for full court fee (both teams fees). If a team regularly defaults or is unreliable, then that team will be taken out of competition and will be charged 3 weeks discharge fee (same as game fees).
- **UMPIRES** - Please respect the umpires decision at all times. Be assured that they are well versed in all rule interpretations and will umpire your game to the best of their ability. In some instances you may feel a call has gone against you to your disadvantage but more than likely it has happened to the other team as well and it will all balance out in the end. Remember, the umpire may not always see everything and their job is not an easy one. Players may ask for rule clarification at the end of each game or half-time break. An umpires decision on court is final. Umpires should keep their own score, however, if both teams agree, a person from the side-line may keep the score.
- **TEAM CAPTAIN RESPONSIBILITY** - The captains have the responsibility to ensure that their teams know the time for the game and that the team arrive 10 mins before the games are due to start. This is to ensure that games are not held up because of a late start. Teams responsible for late starts will be penalised and time taken off to ensure our schedule is not disrupted. The Stadium provides timetables once grading games have been completed. These are available to all players from office.
- **PLAYER RESPONSIBILITY** - As a regular member of the team, you have made a playing commitment to them for the league. In some instances you are not going to be able to play and we would recommend to teams that this individual is responsible for finding another player. If you or the team is unable to find a replacement player, the Stadium can help find one for you, however, you may be responsible for payment of that player. The team is responsible for full team payment.
- **REFUNDS** - If a game is called off because of a last minute default, the team who is waiting to play will receive a full refund **if they do not play**. Teams do not have a choice if a team is found to play. However, the team who is responsible for the default will be liable for full court fee payment if the game is cancelled. Please remember that you are disrupting not only the Stadiums schedule, but also the other team who have turned up expecting to play.
In the event of an Umpires decision calling the game off due to rough play etc, or a team leaving the court prior to the games allocated time, no team refunds will be given. Individual players removed from the game by an umpire are not entitled to a refund (full team payment rule applies in all situations).

RULES OF THE GAME - Make sure all members of the team know the rules of the game. A copy is available in office for your team to read. Local bi-rules apply with the assistance of the following national rules:

Netball: Rules are played under the jurisdiction of NZ Indoor Netball Rules Book 1990 Edition in conjunction with current NZ National Indoor Netball Tournament Rules.

Cricket: Rules are played as set out in 1990 and 1993 NZ Indoor Cricket Rule Books and any rule changes/additions as set by NZ Council since these dates.

Soccer: As set out in Action Indoor Sports Rule Book.

- **ETIQUETTE** - Players, supporters, families and/or spectators are all welcome. Fun is the name of the game, whether you are here to play, watch or encourage play. For your enjoyment and benefit please note the following:
Management: All questions, queries or complaints should be directed to Management only except wherein questions relating to rules of the game shall be directed to the Umpire. Wherein a dispute arises between an Umpire and player, the dispute will be directed to Management (after the game). Formal complaints are requested to be in writing.
Children: Children must be under adult supervision at all times. Children are not to be left unattended at any time. Children must not be left alone in the indoor or outdoor playground.
Damages: Any person(s) responsible for damage to any Stadium property or equipment will be liable for payment.
Etiquette: Swearing, abusive behaviour or physical violence towards players, umpires or any other person will not be tolerated. On-court warnings will be given and offenders may be asked to leave the premises and may be banned indefinitely (including spectators).
Smoking: The Stadium is Smoke-Free. Smoking is not permitted anywhere within the Stadium and 4m of entrance ways.
PLEASE KEEP THE STADIUM TIDY - Rubbish tins are provided for your convenience.

NOTE: The Management of Action Indoor Sports Stadium reserve the right to ask any person to leave at any time. As will all sports, there is always a risk of injury and all players participate at own risk.
