THE ACTION TEAM

SOCCER BASICS

- Each game consists of four eight minute quarters.
- Six players may take part in any one game, with a maximum of four players being permitted on the court at any one time.
- There are four playing positions, Attack, Centre, Defence and Goalkeeper.
- Attack players are permitted to move anywhere within their team's attacking half, but not the goal circle.
- Defence players are permitted to move anywhere within their team's defending half, but not the goal circle.
- Centre players are permitted to move anywhere within the entire court, with the exception of the goal circles at either end of the court.
- Goalkeepers must remain in the goal circle at all times.
- Mixed teams must have a minimum of one female player and a maximum of three male players on the court at all times and one male player must be the goalkeeper.
- Successful shots at goal can only be taken from outside the goal circle by either an Attack player or Centre Player.
- Successful shots at goal taken by a female player are worth two goals and by male players are worth one goal.
- The nets surrounding the court may all be used to either make or receive passes to or from another player.
- The remaining match rules are based on the traditional outdoor game, and are contained in a rule book that is available to all

STADIUM POLICY

COMPETITION FORMAT

A typical season consists of pre-season grading games, competition round games, and depending on how your team has fared in the round games, semi-finals and finals. All finals are held on the same day, and prizes are awarded to the winners and runners up in all grades.

PLAYING DAYS

Each team will play their games on both their preferred playing day and on some Sundays. By far the majority of each team's games will be scheduled on their preferred playing day, but there will be some games scheduled to be played on Sundays during each competition and all teams are expected to play all scheduled games.

Following are the days on which our various sports are played...

Mens Indoor Soccer - Tuesday, Thursday, Friday, Sunday

Mixed Indoor Soccer - Thursday, Friday, Sunday

PLAYING TIMES

To enable us to provide your teams with the most suitable schedule of game times possible, when entering your team you must select which time zones are best suited to your team on both your preferred playing day and on Sundays.

REGISTRATION FEES

Each new team must pay a \$50.00 Team Registration Fee, and this fee must be paid prior to each team's first game.

MATCH FEES

We now offer you two methods of payment, pay as you play or pay the whole season up front ...

Senior Soccer: Pay as you play.. - \$60.00 per team per match

Senior Soccer: Pay up front... - \$54.00 per team per match

Friday & Sunday Indoor Soccer - \$48.00 per team per match

CANCELLATION OF GAMES

To enable us to maintain our payment structure, all teams must play all of their scheduled games. If a team cancels or defaults any game the following will apply:

- 1) Cancellation of any game will incur a \$30.00 default fee regardless of any notice given.
- 2) Cancellation of any game within 72 hours of a scheduled game time will incur a \$60.00 default fee.
- 3) Canceling or not showing up to any game on the scheduled day of play will incur a \$90.00 default fee

Our competitions run all year round, and following is a schedule of the timings in which each of our competitions are played.
